The Charitable Foundation of the Energy Bar Association ("CFEBA") has arranged to provide ten portable electric generators to the State of Louisiana to assist regions heavily impacted by Hurricane Katrina and lacking utility services. The generators will be delivered to the Port of Baton Rouge and are expected to be used principally in St. Bernard, Plaquemines and Washington Parishes. Delivery is scheduled for mid-week.

The CFEBA intends to provide additional generators to hurricane-stricken areas of Mississippi and Louisiana in the coming days.
