The Board of Directors of Arlingtonians Meeting Emergency Needs, Inc. joins me in expressing our gratitude to the Board of Charitable Foundation of the Energy Bar Association for the recent grant of \$5,000. These funds will help AMEN provide emergency financial assistance for utility bills to Arlington residents with the greatest need. Please know that your support has been particularly crucial during this challenging economic time.

Each month since December 2008, AMEN has provided more than \$50,000 in financial assistance to over 220 clients and households. In the twelve months ending June, 2009, we have assisted approximately 2700 clients with a total of over \$600,000 to help meet emergency financial needs. For fiscal year 2009, AMEN provided \$134,918 in emergency payments for gas and electric utility bills to 522 households. Current fiscal year to date spending for utilities is slightly higher than last year's. This amount is significantly more than the assistance AMEN provided in each of the previous two years and it reflects just how serious the economic downturn is affecting individuals and households in Arlington.

Although Arlington and the surrounding DC Metropolitan area are often described as recession-proof, there are still many of our neighbors who have lost their jobs and now face other financial emergencies. Without AMEN's help, many of those would become homeless; or would go without heat and/or electricity. This is why AMEN's mission of providing financial assistance for emergency needs is so important. Without your support, our work would not be possible.

Thank you once again. We are most grateful for the Foundation's interest and support of our work in Arlington.

On behalf of Jewish World Watch we want to extend our deepest and most sincere gratitude to you for your generous donation of \$5,280.00 to our Solar Cooker Project. Your leadership and commitment to this project is so appreciated! As you know, this donation is helping to bring solar cookers to women and girls in refugee camps in Chad and has helped us launch our project in a third camp.

Jewish World Watch began the Solar Cooker Project with the dual aims of decreasing the exposure of the women survivors of the genocide in Darfur to rape, and addressing the severe firewood shortage in the Darfur region. From many reports we learned that women are often exposed to violence and rape when they leave the camps to forage for wood to cook their food; in addition, deforestation and global warming have severely decreased the supply of available firewood. The Solar Cooker Project addresses both of these concerns. It also has a very important economic development component: women in the refugee camps are hired and paid to manufacture the solar cookers and to perform the function of training the other women in using this new cooking strategy.

We have successfully completed outfitting our first two refugee camps, Iridimi and Touloum, and have begun training in a third camp, the Oure Cassoni camp, home to 28,000 refugees. Your donation will help jumpstart the project at Oure Cassoni and help to provide replacement cookers for the first two camps. We are working closely with the United Nations High Commission on Refugee to encourage the UN to convert the other camps in Chad and Darfur to solar cooking as well.

In addition to this important initiative, other Jewish World Watch funds support a multitude of projects, bringing desperately needed relief to some of the more than 2.7 million Darfuris, who have been displaced from their homes and are completely dependant on foreign aid, as well as education and advocacy projects here in Los Angeles, building a strong community of activists. 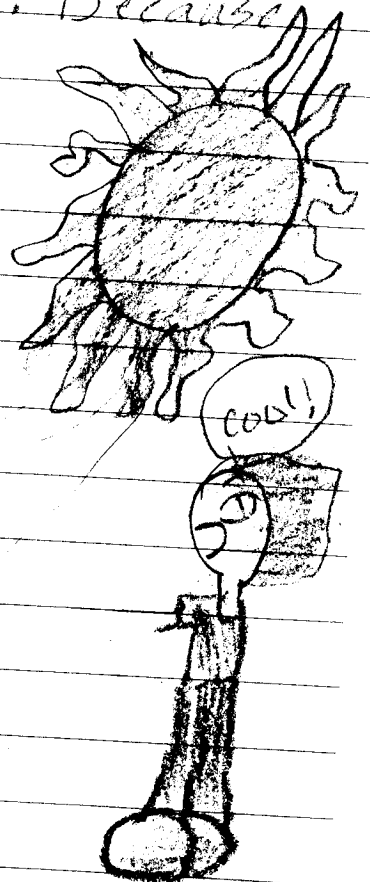
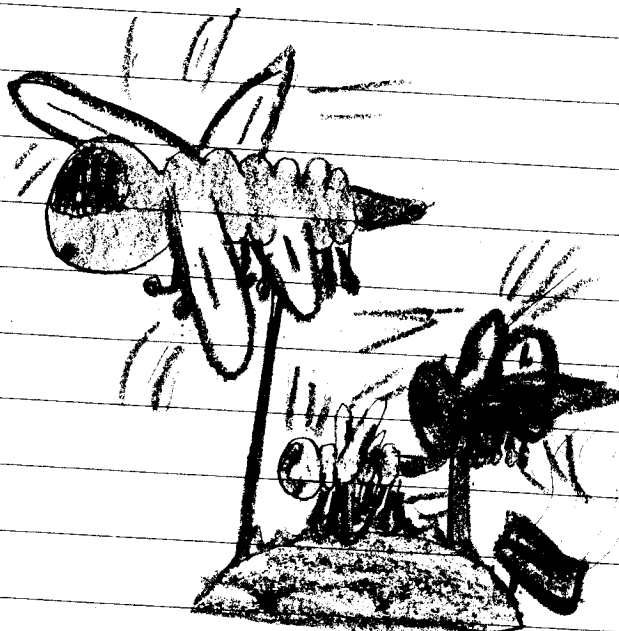
Dear CFEBA,

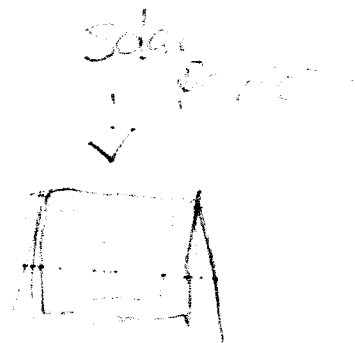
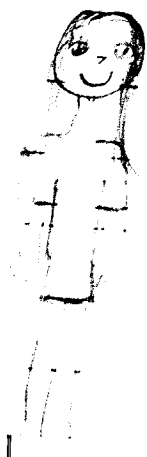
Dear CFEB A
