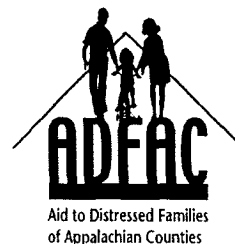

This is a truly wonderful and extraordinarily generous gift that will help meet one of our biggest needs at AAH.

As you may know, AAH is a model school intended to combine the best elements of Uganda's education system with the best aspects of American education. We provide lunch to our students, have small class sizes (approximately 40 students compared to 100 in a government school), encourage reading and learning in small groups, and have an extensive extra curricular program. Our students are taught to master the ABCs of success – high academic standards, good behavior and strong character. Above all, we teach our students to be creative, innovative thinkers who can help transform their community.

Having solar power at the school will provide a more dependable and consistent energy source to AAH, and enable our students to make full use of the classrooms and library facilities both during the day and in the evening. Also, extended availability of power at our facilities will make it possible to hold many after school-activities. Students from other schools will make use of these facilities in the evenings, as will the local community. This will dramatically expand the number of people benefiting from AAH programs. We are so grateful for your gift.

Thank you again for your very generous support of AAH and for pioneering intervention in funding a program that will serve hundreds if not thousands of Ugandan children.
